Buck Knives is an American knife manufacturer located in Post Falls, Idaho. The company started in 1902 and has been handed down through 5 generations. Buck Knives primarily manufactures sport and field knives and is credited with inventing the "folding hunting knife" and popularizing it to such a degree that the term "buck knife" has become synonymous with folding lockback knives, including those made by other manufacturers.

THE OPPORTUNITY
